Easter activities were abounding in Pre-K this week. The kids worked on decorating eggs in patterns. They also listened Carefully to step-bystep directions during a directed drawing activity. The results were Cute bunnies that the kids then painted with watercolors.

During our small groups the students once again participated in Easter-themed activities that included a syllable count, Roll-aBunny game, and a number game. During the number game the students worked to match 10 frames and fingers to numbers.

Easter activities were also added to many of our interest centers. At the writing Center an Easter word Chart was added for those kids interested in Copying words or making books. Stuffed bunnies were added to the block center and many homes or hutches were made for the bunnies. In the math Center,

Easter erasers and Easter eggs were a new addition. Here we saw the kids counting objects and matching to numbered eggs, making patterns, sorting erasers, and just using their imaginations. It is amazing how simple things like CharaCter erasers Can be used to develop so many different skills!
